The Pocahontas County Artisan Co-Op (PCACo-OP) is seeking art and craft demonstrators to provide public art-based demonstrations in our local communities. Individuals may apply as a Juried Demonstrator by submitting the attached application and agreeing to participate in a jury process established by the PCACo-Op. The jury staff will review and choose qualified demonstrators based on professionalism, quality, craftsmanship, depth of variety, display look, and how the art relates to the non-profit mission of supporting the arts and crafts in our local community.

All demonstrations will be held at PCACo-Op sponsored gallery locations either in Marlinton or Cass for a 4-hour duration on the assigned day. PCACo-Op will compensate demonstrators \$150 for skills and knowledge. Juried Demonstrators may sell their artwork during the hours of their demonstration and will be responsible for all taxes associated with the art sales.
